**NEW:** Beginning with the October 2024 release, three new files have been added to make using ScribeFax simple to use. The new files are compatible with Excel, and contain not only the the above information, but also names, addresses, phones, specialties, and other data from the relational database tables shown below, just for the records that display a BestFax number. This ends duplication of rows caused by numbers numbers from multiple sources and Failed numbers. The new files are:

- ScribeFax\_BestFax\_Physician.csv contains all physician (MD, DO) BestFax records
- ScribeFax\_BestFax\_PA-APN.csv contains all physician assistant (PA) and advanced practice nurses (APN) BestFax records
- ScribeFax\_BestFax\_OtherAlliedHCP.csv contains remaining prescribers' BestFax records (including other nurses, dentists, podiatrists, vision care, chiropractic physicians, mental health)

The following data (a subset of our CarePrecise Complete data package) is sourced and merged from the NPPES, PECOS and LEIE databases, keyed on the NPI. Every record has a unique NPI, and the NPI is used to link the relational tables together, and with the ScribeFax file described above. The PhoneFax table is included to add the phone number, but the enhanced data fax number in the PrescriberFax Enhanced table is the one intended for use.
